## The paradox

88 million tons of food is wasted every year in Europe (European Commission, 2016). At the same time, 42 million people cannot afford a quality meal every second day (Eurostat, 2016).

## Our mission

To contribute to reducing hunger and malnutrition in Europe, through the fight against food waste and the call for solidarity, by supporting and developing food banks in countries where they are most needed.

## Food banks

A unique solution which:

- Provides food and solidarity to the most deprived, often the first step towards social inclusion
- Contributes to reducing food waste by redistributing large quantities of edible surplus
- Generates savings for partner charities freeing up funds that they can use to invest in their core missions
- Enables food companies to reduce their losses and minimize their disposal costs
- Strengthens social cohesion by calling for volunteers and building partnerships between public, private and nonprofit bodies
- Turns each euro spent into distributed food which has a net worth of between €8 to €20

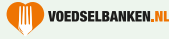
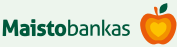
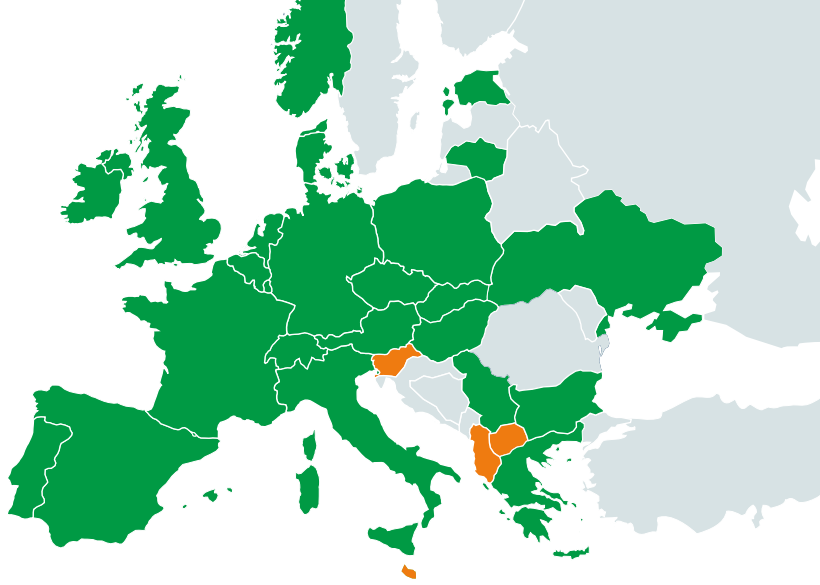
