



The European Food Banks Federation (FEBA) partners with ADM Cares to host Volunteer Week across Europe

670 ADM employees came together in twenty six countries in Europe, Middle East and Africa to take part in dozens of activities for a total of more than 1,000 volunteer hours.

The activities included preparing emergency food aid packages with Stichting Voedselbank Rotterdam and Stichting Voedselbank Amsterdam in the **Netherlands**, Partage in **Switzerland** and Magyar Élelmiszerbank Egyesület in **Hungary**, preparing food aid packages with Rivas-Vacia in Madrid and Casa Caridad, Valencia, in **Spain** and collecting food items in Erith and Purfleet in the **UK** with the Trussell Trust.

The ADM team also participated in cooking activities with Asociatia Copii pentru Viitor in **Romania** in addition to working on anti-food waste sessions with Les Cuisiniers Solidaires in **France**.

The Volunteer Week also promoted a Sports Challenge during which for every kilometer the ADM team ran, swam or biked, it unlocked a USD 1 donation. The activity totaled close to 22 thousand kilometers, which will be reverted into a USD 22k donation to FEBA.

This is the first year FEBA and ADM Cares came together to host volunteering activities across European locations.

“Volunteering is an essential part of the DNA of Food Banks. Thanks to the support of ADM Cares, our Members will scale operations to daily respond to the increase in food demand”, says Jacques Vandenschrik, the President of the European Food Banks Federation (FEBA).

ADM has a long tradition in working with non-profit partners by directing funds to initiatives that support education, food security and hunger relief, as well as sustainability. The company established the Volunteer Week in the EMEA region to encourage colleagues to join volunteer activities to engage with and support local communities.
